1. Please place all of the food items from the list below in ONE reusable grocery/shopping bag. The plastic and paper bags break, and we have a mess. Boxes are harder and heavier to transport and distribute to the families. If you must use 2 bags, please mark them and tie them together securely.

2. Please place your food card in an envelope at the top of the bag. We will remove them (for security) and give them to Holy Name in one big envelope. We control your gift cards and food donations very carefully.

3. We regret we cannot accept late deliveries. The food must be delivered by us to Holy Name in time for them to distribute the food on the 19th.
